Grow your own organic fruit and vegetable garden. Start easy with things like cress, mint and tomatoes.

Make your own birdfeeders. You can recycle old plastic bottles and fill them with seeds, use toilet rolls holders and peanut butter or make simple ones with string.



Make a bug hotel to attract lots of different insects. These can be created using old pots, pieces of wood, pine cones and compost.



Create a Butterfly/Bumble Bee Garden by planting lots of different wildflower seeds.

Create a Fairy Garden. Design your own miniature garden in a planter or plant pot and leave it outside. Watch which species it attracts and keep an eye out for any fairy footprints!



Build your own bird bath or bird box in the garden and see how many different birds it attracts.
